Introduction & Text Review

- ◆ One of the reasons Christ gave us the Holy Spirit is to empower the believer to be godlier or spiritual ₹n. 16:12-15
- ◆ The Holy Spirit convicts us of sin, guides us in our choices as believers thereby enabling us produce godly characteristics referred to as the 'fruit o the Spirit' Jn. 16:8; Eph. 3:16; Jn. 16:13

Why "FRUIT"?

Why does the Holy Spirit use 'fruit' to depict the characteristics of the believer?

Why "FRUIT"?

A fruit is defined as the sweet and fleshy product of a tree or other plant that contains seed and can be eaten as food

Why "FRUIT"?

- Faith is like a tree and trees require tending (Lk. 17:6; Mk. 4:31)
 - ◆ If we give the tree nourishment (God's Word), then it will grow bigger I

 Peter 1:23; I Pet. 2:2
 - ◆ If we <u>clear the weeds and insects (sinful tendencies)</u> Eph. 4:22-31; Col. 3:8-10, then we keep the tree healthy
 - ◆ If we consult a professional gardener (God) 1 Chron. 16:11 then we will ensure we are on the right track
- The 'fruit of the Spirit' refers to the results that SHOULD be seen in our lives if we allow the Holy Spirit's work in our hearts Rom. 8:9; Rom. 12:1-2



The Opposite of Bearing Fruit

Stagnation and ultimately death is the opposite of bearing fruit - James

2:14-26; Rom. 6:20-23; Prov. 14:12

- There is a list of things that everyone who is not fully under the Holy Spirit's influence will have problems with Gal. 5:19-21
- ► When a christian does not bear the fruit of the Spirit, he/she is more likely to bear these fruits
- The danger with this is that people who do any of these DO NOT have a part in God's Kingdom

Wrong Doctrine

Wild Parties

Jealousy & Anger

Hatred & Fighting

Drunkenness

Causing trouble

Murder

Eagerness for lustful pleasure

Complaints & Criticisms

Spiritism - encouraging activity of demons

Doing Shameful things

Taking part in witchcraft

Constant effort to get the best for yourself

Feeling that everyone else is wrong except those in your own little group

Conclusion

On one hand, our sinfulness produces rotted, poisoned fruit which reflects our sinful nature and hurts us in the end. On the other hand, the Holy Spirit produces beautiful, nourishing fruit that reflects God's nature and will ultimately benefit our lives
